


# Uplyme & Lyme Regis Horticultural Society

### PUMPKINS, PIES AND PICKLES



Village Hall, Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2017, 7.30 pm

Exhibits to be brought to the Hall at 7.00 pm, entries on the day.  
There will be a bring-and-share supper.

**Judges:** Cookery and preserves judges – to be appointed.  
For all other classes (except 15), members will vote on their favourite exhibits.  
Rosettes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>.

#### CLASSES OF ENTRY

- FLOWERS**
1. **Garden Flowers** – annuals/biennials/perennials – one vase of one kind
  2. **Garden Flowers** – annuals/biennials/perennials – one vase of mixed kinds
- FLORAL ART**
3. **'Autumn'**– may contain fresh and/or dried leaves, flowers, stems, seed heads, etc. (Space for each exhibit 60cms square. Open staging)
  4. **'Pumpkins & Black Berries'** – use your imagination to create a table decoration in a carved or uncarved pumpkin 'bowl'
- FRUIT**
5. **Apples**, dessert – 5 (not exceeding 80 mm. in diameter) – named variety if possible
  6. **Pears**, dessert – 3 named variety if possible
  7. **A Basket of Home-grown Fruit** – to be judged on presentation, quality and variety
- VEGETABLES**
8. **One Pumpkin or Winter Squash** – any variety
  9. **Culinary Herbs** – a collection of mixed culinary herbs (not flowering), in water, to be judged on presentation, quality and variety
  10. **'October Harvest'** – a collection of mixed vegetables displayed in a container, to be judged on presentation, quality and variety
- COOKERY**
11. **Apple Pie** - shallow plate pie with pastry top and bottom
  12. **A Decorated Sponge Cake with an Autumn theme**

- PRESERVES**
13. A jar of **Piccalilli**
  14. A jar of **Plum Jam**  
[No commercial name to appear on any container or lid. Either metal twist top (with inner plastic coating for pickles) or waxed disc and cellophane may be used. Wax disc not needed with metal lids, but there must be a seal of preservation.]
- FUN**
15. **Uplyme's Heaviest Marrow** – to be judged on weight only.
- CRAFT**
16. **'Harvest Festival'** – a picture/collage/photo/digital image in any medium or size to represent the season's harvest (Not to exceed 60cms square)

#### **Show Rules**

1. Classes 1, 2, 5-10 and class 15 must be home-grown.
2. Entries to be brought to Uplyme Village Hall at 7 pm on the evening.
3. Class cards will be available for each entry to be filled out at the registration desk.
4. Exhibitors to provide their own receptacles.
5. No exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit in any one class.
6. This is a 'fun' competition designed for the enjoyment of members, and to encourage everyone to have-a-go at gardening. Judging in most classes will be by popular vote, and not by Royal Horticultural Society Rules.
7. Whilst every reasonable care will be taken, the Committee will not be held responsible for any loss of, or damage to, exhibits.
8. In the event of any question or dispute, the decision of the Committee will be final.
