**Judges:** Cookery and preserves judges – to be appointed.  
For all other classes (except 15), members will vote on their favourite exhibits.  
Rosettes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>.

### CLASSES OF ENTRY

- FLOWERS**
1. **Garden Flowers** – annuals/biennials/perennials – one vase of one kind
  2. **Garden Flowers** – annuals/biennials/perennials – one vase of mixed kinds
- FLORAL ART**
3. **'Mists & Mellow Fruitfulness'** – Space for each exhibit 60cm square. Open staging
  4. **'Seaside'** – a table decoration, space available 20cm square.  
*Classes 3 & 4 may contain fresh and/or dried leaves, flowers, stems, seed heads, fruits, vegetables, etc. together with any item appropriate to the theme – let your imagination go wild!*
- FRUIT**
5. **Apples**, dessert – 3 – named variety if possible
  6. **Pears**, dessert – 3 - named variety if possible
  7. **A Basket of Home-grown Fruit** – to be judged on presentation, quality and variety
- VEGETABLES**
8. **Funniest Root Veg** – any variety/type.
  9. **Culinary Herbs** – a collection of mixed culinary herbs (not flowering), in water, to be judged on presentation, quality and variety
  10. **'September Harvest'** – a collection of mixed vegetables displayed in a container, to be judged on presentation, quality and variety
- COOKERY**
11. **A Plum Tart**
  12. **An Apple cake**
- PRESERVES**
13. A jar of **Pear Chutney**
  14. A jar of **Blackberry and Apple Jam**  
*To be consistent with our Summer Show, no commercial name to appear on any container or lid. Either metal twist top (with inner plastic coating for pickles) or waxed disc and cellophane may be used. Wax disc not needed with metal lids, but there must be a seal of preservation. **BUT THE PRESERVES WILL BE JUDGED ONLY ON COLOUR, TEXTURE AND TASTE.***
- FUN**
15. **One Winter Squash** – to be judged on weight only – any variety of Pumpkin or Winter Squash can be entered, but no marrows please.

### **Show Rules and Judging**

1. Classes 1, 2, 5-10 and class 15 must be home-grown.
2. Entries to be brought to Uplyme Village Hall at 7 pm on the evening.
3. Class cards will be available for each entry to be filled out at the registration desk.
4. Exhibitors to provide their own receptacles.
5. No exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit in any one class.
6. This is a 'fun' competition designed for the enjoyment of members, and to encourage everyone to have-a-go at gardening. Judging in most classes will be by popular vote, and not by Royal Horticultural Society Rules.
7. Whilst every reasonable care will be taken, the Committee will not be held responsible for any loss of, or damage to, exhibits.
8. In the event of any question or dispute, the decision of the Committee will be final.
