CLASSES OF ENTRY

- FLOWERS**
1. **Garden Flowers** – annuals/biennials/perennials – one vase of one kind
 2. **Garden Flowers** – annuals/biennials/perennials – one vase of mixed kinds
- FLORAL ART**
3. **'Shades of Autumn'** – Space for each exhibit 60cm square. Open staging
 4. **'Berry Magic'** – a table decoration, space available 20cm square.
Classes 3 & 4 may contain fresh and/or dried leaves, flowers, stems, seed heads, fruits, vegetables, etc. together with any item appropriate to the theme – let your imagination go wild!
- FRUIT**
5. **Apples**, dessert – 3 – named variety if possible
 6. **Pears**, dessert – 3 - named variety if possible
 7. **A Basket of Home-grown Fruit** – to be judged on presentation, quality and variety
- VEGETABLES**
8. **Culinary Herbs** – a collection of mixed culinary herbs, in water, to be judged on presentation, quality and variety
 9. **'October Harvest'** – a collection of mixed vegetables displayed in a container, to be judged on presentation, quality and variety.
- COOKERY**
10. **A Fruit Crumble**
 11. **A Vegetable Cake** – a cake made from carrot, pumpkin, courgette, beetroot, or parsnip.
 12. **Autumn Fairy Cakes**
A plate of cakes decorated to reflect Autumn. Please note: the fairies used could have been caught in any season.
- PRESERVES**
13. A jar of **Your Favourite Chutney**
 14. A jar of **Your Favourite Jam**
The Preserves Will Be Judged Only On Colour, Texture And Taste.
- FUN**
15. **A Fruit Liqueur**
 16. **A Carved Pumpkin**

Show Rules and Judging

1. Classes 1, 2, and 5-9 must be home-grown.
2. Entries to be brought to Uplyme Village Hall at 7 pm on the evening.
3. Class cards will be available for each entry to be filled out at the registration desk.
4. Exhibitors to provide their own receptacles.
5. No exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit in any one class.
6. This is a 'fun' competition designed for the enjoyment of members, and to encourage everyone to have-a-go at gardening. Judging in most classes will be by popular vote, and not by Royal Horticultural Society Rules.
7. Whilst every reasonable care will be taken, the Committee will not be held responsible for any loss of, or damage to, exhibits.
8. In the event of any question or dispute, the decision of the Committee will be final.
