Autumn Harvest Show 2022 Uplyme Village Hall Saturday 8th October 2022 at 10.00 am

Exhibits to be brought to the hall on the day at 9.30am – no pre-registration required. There will be a coffee morning in the hall from 10.00am to 12 noon. There will also be a plant stall for which donations of plants will be welcome from 9.30am.

Judging: For all classes not judged by weight or measurement the judging will be by public vote for favourite exhibits. The public vote will close at 11.15 so that votes can be counted and results announced.

CLASSES OF ENTRY

FLOWERS

1. **Garden Flowers** – annuals/biennials/perennials – one vase of mixed kinds
2. **Chrysanthemums** – 3 blooms, any variety – can be mixed varieties
3. **Dahlias** - 3 blooms, any variety – can be mixed varieties
4. **'The Best Flower from My Garden'** – 1 stem or spray

FLORAL ART

5. **'Autumn Colours'** – space for each exhibit 60cm square, open staging
6. **'Autumn's Harvest'** – a table decoration, space available 20cm square using a potato as a base for the arrangement

Classes 5 & 6 may contain fresh and/or dried leaves, flowers, stems, seed heads, fruits, vegetables etc. together with any item appropriate to the theme!

FRUIT

7. **Apples**, dessert or cooking – 3 – named variety if possible
8. **Pears**, dessert – 3 – named variety if possible
9. **A basket of Home-grown Fruit** – to be judged on presentation, quality and variety

VEGETABLES

10. **'Autumn Harvest'** – a collection of mixed vegetables displayed in a container, to be judged on presentation, quality and variety
11. **Chillies** – 3 – named variety if possible
12. **Pumpkin or Winter Squash** – any variety

COOKERY

13. **Cupcakes** – a plate of 3 cupcakes decorated with an autumn theme. To be judged on presentation only.
14. **Decorated Biscuits** – a plate of 3 biscuits decorated with an autumn theme. To be judged on presentation only.

FUN

15. **Photograph 'Autumn Glory'**
16. **Funniest Root Veg** – any variety/type
17. **Heaviest Marrow** – to be judged on weight only
18. **Longest Parsnip** – to be judged on measurement only

Show Rules

1. Classes 1-4, 7-12 and 16-18 must be home-grown.
2. Entries to be brought to Uplyme Village Hall at 9.30am on the day of the show.
3. Class cards will be available for each entry to be filled out at the registration desk.
4. Exhibitors to provide their own receptacles.
5. No exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit in any one class.
6. This is a fun competition designed for the enjoyment of members and supporters of the Society, and to encourage everyone to have a go at entering. Judging in all classes will be by popular vote or by weight and measurement and not to RHS Rules.
7. Whilst every reasonable care will be taken, the Committee will not be held responsible for any loss of, or damage to, exhibits.
8. In the event of any question or dispute, the decision of the Committee will be final.
9. All entries to be removed at 12 noon on the day of the show.
